January 3, 2017

On January 3, 2017, The Millwood Board of Fire Commissioners held the Annual Organizational Meeting at 7pm at Station No. 1 located at 100 Millwood Road in the Town of New Castle. Present at the meeting were Commissioners: Alan Schapiro, Anthony Olenik, Dan Puszka, Commissioner Elect(s) Jason Licthenthal & Michael Wolfensohn, Treasurer Rose Cohen, Secretary Paul Michael Marinello, Chief Greg Santone, 1st Assistant Chief Jorge Rodrigues, 2nd Assistant Chief Jan Schwark, Captain Frank Nestro and firefighter Robert Corerra.

The Organizational meeting was called to order by Commissioner Alan Schapiro.

Notary Public/Secretary Paul Michael Marinello administered the Oath of Office to Commissioner Elect Jason Lichtenthal.

Notary Public/Secretary Paul Michael Marinello administered the Oath of Office to Commissioner Elect Michael Wolfensohn.

Commissioner Schapiro nominated Commissioner Puszka to be temporary Chairman, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor.

Commissioner Puszka nominated Alan Schapiro as Chair of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor.

Chairman Schapiro nominates Dan Puszka as Vice Chair of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in favor.

Secretary Marinello confirms that all regular media outlets were notified of the Annual Organizational Meeting via the Districts' web site, a push list email, and notices at both fire stations, notices at the Town of New Castle and the Millwood Post Office as well as a legal notice which was posted in the Journal News.

Chairman Schapiro made a motion to allow non-District residents to hold the post of Secretary/Records Management Officer and Treasurer, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor.

Chairman Schapiro nominates Paul Michael Marinello for the position Secretary and Records Management Officer at an hourly rate of \$33 per to be paid monthly, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor.

Chairman Schapiro nominates Rose Cohen for the position Treasurer at an hourly rate of \$50 per to be paid monthly, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor.

Notary Public/Secretary Paul Michael Marinello administered the Oath of Office to Treasurer Rose Cohen.

Chairman Schapiro nominates William N. Young Jr. of Wein, Young, Fenton & Kelsey as District Counsel with an annual retainer of \$2,000, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor.

Commissioner Olenik requests that the Treasurer submit the Annual Report for 2015 at the February monthly meeting.

Chairman Schapiro moves to designate the Journal News as the official District newspaper, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor.

Chairman Schapiro made a motion to designate Chase bank as the official bank for the fire district, Seconded by Commissioner Olenik, All in Favor. The maximum value of accounts is approximately \$2,658,272.

Commissioner Puszkamoves that the District join the following Organizations, Seconded by Commissioner Schapiro, All in Favor.
