June 26th, 2017

On June 26th, 2017, The Millwood Board of Fire Commissioners held their regular monthly meeting at 7:30 pm at Station No. 1 located at 100 Millwood Road in the Town of New Castle. Present at the meeting were Commissioners: Anthony Olenik, Jason Lichtenthal, Michael Wolfensohn, Secretary Paul Michael Marinello, District Consultant Joe McConnell, Treasurer Rose Cohen, Chief Jorge Rodrigues, 2nd Assistant Chief Frank Nestro and Chiefs' Aid Greg Santone.

Commissioner Olenik called the meeting to order.

Public Comment

There was no public and no public comment.

Chief's Report by Chief Jorge Rodrigues, attached.

Commissioner Wolfensohn made a motion to purchase two haligan tools from Fire End totaling \$464.00. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor. PO # 208

Commissioner Wolfensohn made a motion to purchase two Flat Head Axes from Fire End totaling \$190.00. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor. PO # 209

Commissioner Olenik made a motion to purchase seventy-five yellow safety vests from Ironwear/Auster Rubber Co. totaling \$450.00. Seconded by Commissioner Wolfensohn. All in Favor. PO # 210

Commissioner Olenik made a motion to allow the Fire Company to attend four parades with apparatus using the previously approved budget for band payments. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor. Schedule as follows:

- Croton Fire Department June 10th with Ossining Band costing \$1,000.00
- Mt Kisco Fire Department -- July 14th with Veterans Band costing \$1,150.00
- Ossining Fire Department August 4th with Veterans Band costing \$1,150.00
- Briarcliff Fire Department September 16th with Ossining Band costing \$1,000.00

Commissioner Olenik will investigate the Chief's request to install an electric conduit to the Station 2 training house for two LED light fixtures on the rear of the building.

The Board discussed resurfacing the bay floors and it was agreed for the Chief's Aid and District Secretary to develop a specification package for a formal bid process.

Commissioner Wolfensohn made a motion to allocate up to \$ 150.00 for modifying the banners for this year's Open House in October. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor.

Chief Rodrigues advised the Board that the Annual Open House will be held Saturday October 21st from 1 to 4 PM.

Treasurer's Report: attached by Treasurer Rose Cohen.

The Treasurer noted the addition to the budget of 16,855.00 from 2016 to Equipment Purchase due to the encumbrance of PO # 175.

Commissioner Olenik made a motion to move \$1000 from A19.412 Miscellaneous Budget Line to A34.471 Office Supplies & Sundry Budget Line. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor.

Commissioner Olenik made a motion to Move \$1000 from A407.1 Electricity Budget Line to A34.443 Maintenance Supplies Budget Line. Seconded by Commissioner Wolfensohn. All in Favor.

Commissioner Wolfensohn made a motion to transfer \$50,000.00 from Operating Fund to Capital Reserve Fund. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor.

Commissioner Wolfensohn made a motion to transfer \$197,311.00 from Operating Fund to Equipment Reserve Fund. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor.

Work Session:

Commissioner Olenik made a motion to adopt the amended minutes of the April 6th Special Meeting, Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in Favor.

Commissioner Olenik made a motion to adopt the amended minutes of the May 22nd Regular Meeting, Seconded by Commissioner Wolfensohn. All in Favor.

Commissioner Wolfensohn made a motion to appoint Paul Michael Marinello as a consultant to the District at a rate of \$33.00 per hour not to exceed twelve (12) hours per month. Seconded by Commissioner Lichtenthal. All in favor.

Commissioner Olenik made a motion for Open Systems Metro to install six (6) CO Detectors connected to the alarm system in Station 1 and two (2) battery operated CO Detectors for Station 2 with a total cost not to exceed \$3,500.00. Seconded by Commissioner Wolfensohn. All in Favor.

The Board discussed the contract submitted by Homeland Towers and asked the Secretary to forward to the Fire District Attorney for comments.

Millwood Board of Fire Commissioners Meeting Minutes June 26th, 2017

Commissioner Wolfensohn reported he is working with the cable provider to update the service at Station 2.

The Board discussed erecting an antique alarm bell at Station 1 and Assistant Chief Jan Schwark will handle the installation.

There was discussion on reimbursing Volunteer Members for their gym membership. A decision was tabled until the July meeting.

Chiefs' Aid Santone advised the Board the following:

- D.P. Wolf has repaired the actuator for the roof heating/AC unit and is in process of installing duct work for proper ventilation in the air compressor room.
- Recertification of the Station 1 elevator is in work for a final building Certificate of Occupation.
- The latest estimate to repair the landscape irrigation system is \$3,200.00. There will be a meeting with the Landscaper for options to reduce the cost to \$1,500.00.

The Board asked the Secretary to investigate purchasing for Station 1 two permanent parking lot signs indicating additional parking on the side of the building.

The Chiefs would like to purchase two Flat Head Axes from Fire End @\$95.00 each = \$190.00 PO # _____

The Chiefs staff would like to suggest that the Fire District have a spec. developed for the resurfacing of the bay floors so that eligible contractors can quote the job and eventually the same can be used for the formal bid process.

The Chiefs would like permission to attend 3 parades with apparatus and bands. Mt. Kisco on Friday July 14 with the Vets @ \$1150.00 Ossining on Friday August 4th with the Vets @ \$1150.00 Briarcliff on Saturday September 16th with the Ossining Band @ \$1000.00

The Chiefs would like to purchase 50 safety vests @ \$6.00 each = \$300.00 from Ironwear/ Auster Rubber Co. to be issued to each active FF to keep with his/her turn out gear. PO #

As per Commissioner Puszka's conversation with Captain Raguso, conduit will need to be run to the rear of the training house before Captain Raguso can install the two LED light fixtures on the rear of the building. Would the BoFC like to solicit quotes to do so, or fix a not to exceed amount to have the work done ?

Captain Raguso is in the process of obtaining a firm written and formal confirmation from BSA that the Millwood Explorers would be covered fully under their insurance policy when riding fire apparatus to and participating at an emergency scene.

With the Board's approval, the Chiefs would like to hold the Wetdown for Rescue 36 on Sunday July 30th from 1 to 4PM.

With the Board's approval, the Chiefs would like to hold this year's Open house On Saturday October 21st from 1 to 4PM.

With the Board's approval, the buyer of the old Rescue seems willing to purchase the truck in full, in advance of obtaining the title, if we would reduce the price by approximately \$1500.00 to cover 50% of the fee to have the apparatus trailered to their location.
